- Availability

MFF – FALL FIESTA MAPLE

SKY – SKYLINE HONEYLOCUST *

LIGR – GREENSPIRE LINDEN * (susceptible to Japanese Beetles)

SENT – SENTRY LINDEN

HACK – HACKBERRY

SUN – SUNBURST HONEYLOCUST *

RO – RED OAK *

GIN – AUTUMN GOLD GINKO

NHE – ELM ‘NEW HARMONY’

SGM – MAPLE ‘SIENNA GLEN’

NWR – NORTHWOODS RED MAPLE *

SWO – SWAMP WHITE OAK

MRR – ROYAL RED MAPLE *

ASB – AUTUMN SPLENDOR BUCKEYE * (susceptible to Japanese Beetles)

CSO – CRIMSON SPIRE OAK *

SMA – SHOWY MOUNTAIN ASH *

BPD – PRAIRIE DREAM BIRCH * (**susceptible to Japanese Beetles**)

IMP – HONEYLOCUST ‘IMPERIAL’

NACC – HONEYLOCUST ‘NORTHERN ACCLAIM’

RPO – OAK ‘REGAL PRINCE’

SMALLER, ORNAMENTAL TREES:

HGC – HARVEST GOLD CRABAPPLE *

VPC – VELVET PILLAR CRABAPPLE

JTL – JAPANESE TREE LILAC (“IVORY SILK”)

BB – BLUE BEECH *

ERB – EASTERN REDBUD *

SSC – SPRING SNOW CRABAPPLE *

REJ – “REJOICE” CRABAPPLE *

RRC – CRABAPPLE ‘ROYAL RAINDROPS’

HAW – HAWTHORN (THORNLESS)

SSL – JAPANESE TREE LILAC ‘SUMMER STORM’
